Colposcopy is the key skill that turns an abnormal Pap or HPV result into an accurate diagnosis and timely treatment. This programme is built to make you a confident, competent colposcopist through real, hands-on practice.

About the Training Programme

Our programme combines detailed theoretical teaching with genuine hands-on training. Training is conducted in Delhi on Sundays, and the programme runs every 3–4 months — three to four batches per year. What makes this programme unique is that every participant gets the chance to practise on two patients. This is unlike most other trainings, where a doctor is given practice on only one side or on a single patient. We give certificates to everyone who completes the programme.

Sessions are held in Delhi on Sundays, in small batches, so each doctor receives close, personal supervision.

Course Curriculum

- **Anatomy & Physiology of the Cervix:** The transformation zone, squamocolumnar junction, and metaplasia — the foundation of colposcopy.
- **Screening & Indications:** Where colposcopy fits after Pap smear and HPV testing, and when to refer for colposcopy.
- **The Colposcope & Technique:** Setting up, focusing, and performing a systematic colposcopic examination step by step.
- **Acetic Acid & Lugol's Iodine:** Applying and interpreting acetowhite changes and iodine (Schiller) uptake.
- **Recognising Abnormalities:** Identifying CIN, grading lesions, mosaicism, punctation, and atypical vessels; when to suspect invasion.
- **Directed Biopsy:** Taking an accurate, targeted cervical biopsy and correlating with histopathology.
- **Documentation & Reporting:** Recording findings clearly and structuring a reliable colposcopy report.
- **Management & Follow-Up:** See-and-treat principles, patient counselling, and appropriate follow-up.

Important Information & Terms for Participants

Please read the following carefully before enrolling.

1. **Eligibility & Documentation** — Participants must submit a copy of their medical registration certificate (MCI / State Medical Council such as DMC) along with their qualifying degree (MS, MD, DGO, or equivalent) before the training.
 2. **Schedule** — The programme is conducted in Delhi on Sundays and runs every 3–4 months (3–4 batches per year). Please confirm the date of the next batch at the time of enrolment, as seats in each small batch are limited.
 3. **Practice on Two Patients** — Every participant is given the opportunity to practise on two patients. This is a distinguishing feature of our programme, unlike trainings that offer practice on only one side or a single patient.
 4. **Case Availability** — Cases are arranged through our liaison with associated doctors who provide the patients for training. As we depend on these referrals and on suitable cases being available, timings and case sequence may occasionally change.
 5. **Certification** — A recognized certificate of completion is given to every participant who completes the programme.
 6. **Format of Training** — Our primary focus is hands-on training. Relevant PPTs / presentation material will be provided for theoretical understanding, while colposcopy training will be conducted live, directly on the patient.
 7. **Faculty** — Training will be conducted by either Dr Sujata Mittal or Dr R.N. Mittal.
 8. **Availability & Timing** — As timings may change, participants are requested to remain available throughout the training day.
 9. **Payment Terms** — 70% of the fee must be paid in advance to confirm enrolment.
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
