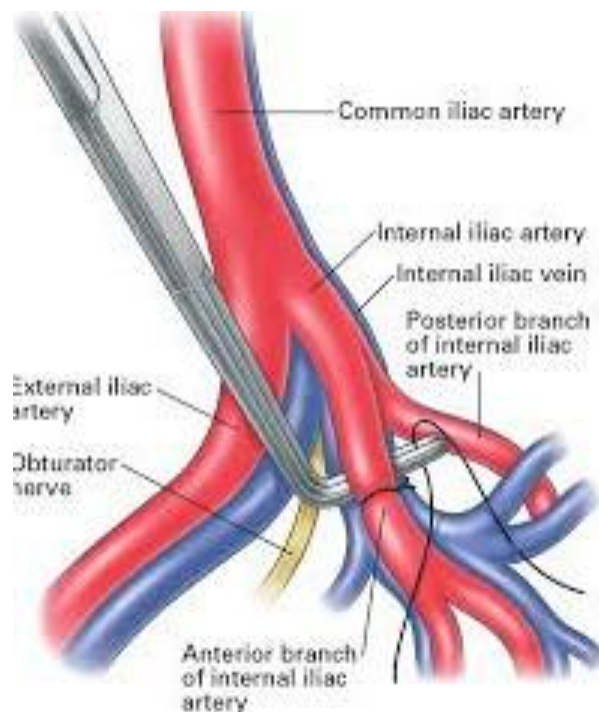

Important Information & Terms for Participants

Please read the following carefully before enrolling.

- 1. Eligibility & Documentation** — Participants must submit a copy of their medical registration certificate (MCI / State Medical Council such as DMC) along with their qualifying degree (MS, MD, DGO, or equivalent) before the training.
 - 2. Prior Preparation** — This is a complex, advanced procedure. Before attending, participants are strongly advised to practise handling the mixer (right-angle artery forceps), as familiarity with this instrument is essential to the technique.
 - 3. Case Availability** — Cases are arranged through our liaison with associated doctors who provide the patients for training. As we depend on these referrals, it may not always be possible to arrange both cases on the same day or exactly as initially scheduled. A case may be postponed or an unforeseen problem may arise, in which event the participant may need to extend their stay by a day or more. Also, it might not be possible to arrange both cases of LSCS, hysterectomy cases might also be kept. In case , you don't want hysterectomy case, you need not apply or if registration is done, complete money will be refunded.
 - 4. Training on Your Own Patients (Preferred)** — Preferably, we would like to conduct the training on the participant's own patients. If you are able to arrange a suitable case from your own practice, this offers the best and most relevant hands-on experience, and we warmly encourage it.
 - 5. Responsibility for Complications** — Participants must understand that if any complication occurs during their practice — particularly while passing the suture beneath the internal iliac artery, where the accompanying vein may be injured — the participant is a party to that complication and may be required to bear the associated charges.
 - 6. Training Setup & Fees** — Such hands-on training is conducted at smaller setups, for which we pay a fee on your behalf. Without this arrangement, no facility permits trainees to operate on private patients.
 - 7. Format of Training** — Our primary focus is hands-on training. Relevant PPTs / presentation material will be provided for theoretical understanding, while anatomical training will be conducted live, directly on the patient.
 - 8. Faculty** — Training will be conducted by either Dr Sujata Mittal or Dr R.N. Mittal.
 - 9. Availability & Timing** — As timings may change at any time, participants are requested to stay nearby and remain available throughout the training period.
 - 10. Payment Terms** — 70% of the fee must be paid in advance to confirm enrolment.
